THENCE \$86°47'30"E, continuing with the north line of said Stivers tract and the south line of said 2.668 acre tract, for a distance of 86.30 feet to the most northerly northeast corner of said Stivers tract, same being the northwest corner of a called 1.65 acre tract as described in the "First Tract" in said Volume 36, Page 160, found a 1/2" iron rod;
